Ticket Guide From Sunday 27th April 2025

This guide gives a summary of our popular and great value tickets available on Stagecoach East Scotland services.

Our simple fares and tickets make it as easy as possible for you to get where you need to be.

Whether you travel with us every day, or every so often, we've got a ticket for you and further information in this guide.

What's changed?

Flexi 10 tickets introduced! - Save 30% with 10 DayRider tickets for the price of 7.

NightRider tickets are now available on the app.

13 week MegaRider tickets for students removed due to low use.

New smartcards are no longer available on our buses, but all tickets can now be bought on our app.

Our Ticket Range - all available on the Stagecoach App!

Ticket type

Single

Valid for 1 journey with adult, child and student options available.

DayReturn

Valid on day of purchase only for a return trip, available all day (until 4am for 1 journey in each direction).

DavRider

Valid for 1 day's unlimited travel within your selected zone (until 4am).

Flexi 5/10

A bundle of 5 DayRider tickets for the price of 4 or 10 DayRider tickets for the price of 7- available for adults and students.

MegaRider

Valid for either 7 days' or 4 weeks' unlimited consecutive travel within your selected zone.

MegaRider Xtra

A MegaRider ticket that is purchased online and paid monthly by recurring payment and automatically added to your smartcard.

NightRider

Unlimited travel within certain areas after 6pm - see page 6.

Our Passengers

Passenger	More information
Adult	Our standard ticket.
Young Children	Up to 4 children aged 4 and under can travel for free with a responsible passenger, however they can't use a seat if it's needed by another passenger.
5-21 Concession	All young people and children aged 5-21 living in Scotland can apply for a national entitlement card providing free bus travel. You can apply for a card via your school or local council and online at freebus.scot
Child	Child tickets are available if you're aged 15 or under and not carrying an NEC card. You may be asked to provide valid photo ID.
Student	You'll need to show a valid student card or digital ID with your photo each time you buy and use our student tickets.
Group	Our group DayRider ticket is valid for up to 5 people travelling together (adults and/or kids) after 9am on weekdays or anytime at the weekend.
Concession	If you're over 60 or have a disability, you could be eligible for free bus travel around Scotland via the National Entitlement Card. You can apply for a card via your local council or at freebus.scot

Don't forget your Pass or ID!

Valid ID is needed for student discount and you must show your free travel pass to use one of the concession schemes. If you've forgotten either, you may need to pay the full adult fare instead.

Carrying your ticket onboard

All customers need to have a valid ticket or pass for their journey. Customers who fail to show this when requested may be asked to pay a standard fare charge of £30 and may face prosecution.

Please ensure your mobile device has suitable battery for your journey if you use a mobile ticket. Many of our buses have USB charging facilities on board!



Making a single trip?

Our single tickets are perfect for you.

Adult singles range from £1.50 - £14. Buy on the Stagecoach app or from your driver.

Did you know that jobseekers can get a 50% discount on singles fares by presenting a Jobseekers Plus travel card?

Returning on the same day?

We have a range of DayReturn tickets available for our most popular journeys that are available all day long on our app or from your driver.

NightRider

Your day's not over with our **NightRider** ticket at only £3.70! Simply buy your ticket on the Stagecoach App, use after 6pm to get unlimited travel on all our services that evening until 4am.

Valid 7 days a week for travel throughout Fife, Perthshire, Dundee, Angus, Stirling and Alloa.

However, its not valid for travel across the Forth to Edinburgh, Forth Valley, Cumbernauld, Glasgow, or North of Montrose towards Aberdeen.

Airport Services

Buy your single ticket to the airport from the app or from the driver, or you can buy a period return valid for a return trip (1 journey in each direction) within 28 days, available any time.

A JET period return is only £21.40, valid from Kinross P&R (on the new JET787 launching 5/5/25!), Halbeath or Ferrytoll P&R to Edinburgh Airport. Don't forget you can park for free at the P&R sites!

Travelling as a pair? Get 2 Period Returns for £38 with the JET DUO ticket, valid from Kinross, Halbeath or Ferrytoll P&R. U16s can buy a JET Period Return for just £1 when travelling with an over 18 too.

Multi-Journey Tickets

Our multi-journey tickets offer great value for money if you're travelling with us more often.

They are split into 3 categories - Town/City, Regional and East Scotland. Check out our zone map on the previous page.

Don't forget our Group DayRider tickets, which offer unlimited travel all day up to five people saving you up to 50% on your travel.

Prices for each category are shown below and we also have specific tickets available for travel on our 19 service.
