We will be making alterations to some of our Cambridgeshire and Busway timetables from Sunday 29th August 2021 in line with the return of schools and colleges for the new academic year. All routes that are not listed below will continue to operate to their current timetables.

Cambridgeshire Service Changes from Sunday 29th August 2021

School Journeys:

Citi 1:

- The Citi 1 Sunday service will operate an additional earlier journey from Arbury to Fulbourn.

Citi 2:

- The Citi 2 will operate a 15 minute frequency to Addenbrooke's via Sainsbury in both directions, Monday to Saturday only.

Route C:

- The C route will be re-introduced between Huntingdon Bus Station and Long Road Sixth Form College to provide additional capacity for students travelling to the college.
- Buses will operate Monday-Friday every 10 minutes at peak times only.
- Buses will also operate Monday-Friday on college holidays as far as Cambridge Rail Station.

Please note: Route C will not serve Long Road Sixth Form College on all journeys. Please check the timetable for specific route information.

Combined Busway Frequencies:

- A, B and C buses will provide a combined frequency of 5 minutes between 07:08 and 08:08 from St Ives Park & Ride to Cambridge.
- For further frequency information please check timetables.

Route V1:

- During morning journeys, route V1 will divert into St Ives Morrisons to become the Busway A. The 05:30 journey from Ramsey will become the 05:59 Busway A and the 06:30 from Ramsey will become the 06:59 Busway A from St Ives Morrisons. In the afternoon, the V1 will begin service at St Ives Bus Station as normal.

Route V3:

- During morning journeys, route V3 will divert into St Ives Morrisons to become the Busway A. The 05:45 journey from Somersham will become the 06:19 Busway A and the 06:45 from Somersham will become the 07:19 Busway A from St Ives Morrisons. In the afternoon, the V3 will begin service at St Ives Bus Station as normal.

Route 904:

- Buses will operate on a one-way clockwise loop around Houghton Village.
- The 14:20 trip from Peterborough to St Ives on school days only will operate 30 minutes later, at 14:50. This allows buses on the route to serve Sawtry School in line with the end of the school day.
